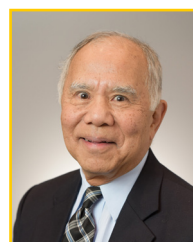
## Cutting Edge Technology with Digital Design & Real World Cosmetic Dentistry; Faults, Failures, and Fixes

Failures in dentistry are frequently blamed on materials, but many times operator error is the culprit. This course will focus on aesthetics that are BUILT TO LAST. Clear, concise and systemized techniques will be presented to treat every aspect involving veneers, crowns and implant restorations. Protocols that will increase profitability by preventing failures occurring day-to-day in your office. Cutting edge preparation techniques that will simplify difficult space management cases, along with how to handle shade challenges when preparation modifications are necessary. State of the art digital smile design linking 3D prosthetic planning with fundamental principles that decreases dentist chair time and ceramist re-work. She will show you how to turn a complicated camera into a point and shoot device and master digital photography. A clinical update on adhesive technology and ceramics will be presented along with specific verbiage to control patient expectations. Dimensions of color and anatomic stratification of anterior composite to attain a polychromatic imperceptible result will be shown. Learning Objectives: Integrate sound occlusal principles to create synergy between form and function; Ability to prepare a difficult space management case; Identify which adhesives and restorative materials work best; Learn matricing techniques and bulkfill technology for mastering posterior composite; and Learn how to achieve a predictable anterior composite restoration following the stratification of opacities to achieve life-like undetectable restorations.

Wednesday, February 9, 2022

**Jon B. Suzuki, DDS, PhD, MBA - Bellevue, WA**

Dr. Jon Suzuki holds Clinical Professorships at the University of Maryland, the University of Washington and Nova Southeastern University. Dr. Suzuki is Professor Emeritus of Microbiology and Immunology (School of Medicine) and Professor Emeritus of Periodontology and Oral Implantology (School of Dentistry) at Temple University, Philadelphia, PA. USA. Dr. Suzuki is the current Chairman of the Food and Drug Administration Dental Products Advisory and Diplomate, Fellow, and Past President of the International Congress of Oral Implantologists. *Dr. Suzuki reports no financial relationships relevant to this presentation to disclose.*



## Updated Contemporary Clinical Periodontology and Oral Implantology 2022

New trends and concepts of the Microbiome in relation to Systemic Diseases, including Heart Attacks, Stroke, Rheumatoid Arthritis, Gastric Ulcers, Neoplasias Alzheimer's Disease, Dementia, and other conditions will be included. Periodontal and Implant Diagnosis and Treatment Planning, with a focus on Peri Implantitis and Implant Failures will be presented, using Case Reports. Surgical and non-surgical approaches to implant rescue will be discussed. In addition Dr Suzuki will present current approaches for understanding COVID vaccines, infections, and immune mechanisms. Course Objectives: Understand the Microbiome in relation to systemic diseases and relate Oral Infections to Systemic Diseases and Conditions; Describe advances in periodontal and implant treatment planning and therapies, including the impact of medications for Dentistry; and Understand concepts of Peri-Implantitis and why Implants fail; Understand COVID vaccines, infections, and immune mechanisms.

Friday, April 8, 2022

**Michael David Scherer, DMD, MS, FACP - Sonora, CA**

Dr. Scherer is a clinical instructor at University of Nevada, Las Vegas, and maintains a practice limited to prosthodontics and implant dentistry in Sonora, CA. He is a fellow of the American College of Prosthodontists, has published articles, DVD training series, and in-person and online courses related to implant dentistry, clinical prosthodontics, and digital technology with a special emphasis on full-arch reconstruction. Dr. Scherer's involvement in digital implant dentistry led him to develop and utilize new technology with CAD/CAM surgical systems, implement interactive CBCT implant planning, and radiographic imaging concepts. Dr. Scherer is the Chief Clinical Advisor for Zest Dental Solutions.



## Diagnosis, Treatment Planning, and Clinical Procedures for Full-Arch Fixed and Removable Implant Rehabilitation

This program will provide a clinical and literature based systematic approach aimed at helping clinicians with treatment planning and the decision-making process for edentulous and partially edentulous patients with fixed and removable prostheses. This process requires balancing patient preferences and finances with a number of clinical factors. Since the choice of fixed versus removable options for both provisional and definitive prostheses is often the most difficult step in treatment planning, special attention is given to considerations for both. Even though the presentation will be heavily focused upon diagnosis & treatment planning and evidence based dentistry, specific clinical procedures and steps will be outlined including clinical and laboratory techniques. Learning Objectives: Understand principles, theory, and procedures of full arch restorative dentistry options; Learn the background research and literature related to removable and fixed restorative options; Exposure to information related to clinical techniques for removable restorations; and Acquire knowledge and confidence with clinical techniques for fixed restorations.

Friday, May, 6 2022

**Chris Salierno, DDS - Melville, NY**

Dr. Chris Salierno is a general dentist from Long Island, New York. He graduated from Stony Brook School of Dental Medicine in 2005. Dr. Salierno has served as the National President of the American Student Dental Association, Chair of the ADA New Dentist Committee, and as President of his local dental society. He lectures internationally on clinical dentistry, practice management, and leadership development. His material can be viewed on his blog, The Curious Dentist. In 2017 he became a Chief Development Officer with the Cellarant Consulting Group. **Anne L. Koch, DMD - Palm Beach Gardens, FL**

Dr. Koch received both her DMD and Certificate in Endodontics from the University of Pennsylvania. She is also the founder and past Director of the Postdoctoral Program in Endodontics at the Harvard School of Dental Medicine. Following her clinical and academic career, Dr. Koch formed her own successful technology and development company, Real World Endo, of which she was CEO and President. Dr. Koch is the holder of multiple patents. *Dr. Koch is a consultant for Real World Endo and Brasseler.*



## Endodontics Revisited

Dr. Koch begins with a review of generic endodontics. Topics include how to perform an accurate endodontic diagnosis and how to achieve profound anesthesia. She will discuss techniques that allows the clinician to perform endodontic therapy without compromising the restorability of the tooth. Dr. Koch will review a discussion of rotary instrumentation and explain why the "Blend Technique" is, in her opinion, the best rotary protocol! "Annie" will focus on bioceramic technology in both endodontics and pediatric dentistry. She will explain why bioceramics became the New Gold Standard of obturation sealers. Dr. Koch will introduce participants to multiple uses of bioceramics in perforation repairs and pulp caps. A rapid-fire Q & A session concludes the day. At the conclusion of this lecture program, attendees will: Understand why there is no such thing as a one-file endodontic protocol; Comprehend the synchronous relationship between endodontics & restorative dentistry; Learn how to successfully hybridize techniques; No longer be intimidated by endodontic emergencies; and Realize that endodontics can be both satisfying to the clinician and beneficial to the patient.
